The five dogs in each category with the most votes as the clock strikes 11:59:59 A.M. on August 31, 2013 will be judged by a panel of expert judges until a winner is selected. A winner in each category will be selected, leaving the "favorite big dog," the "favorite small dog" and the "best dressed dog."
