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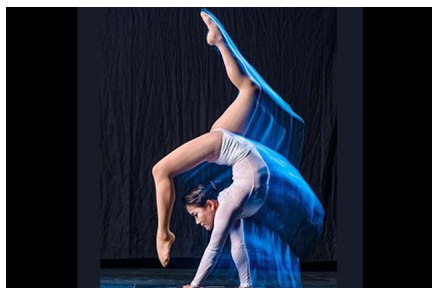
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The Madness of King George – Live Screening

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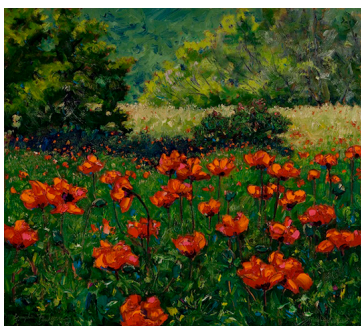
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Disney On Ice presents Dare to Dream
