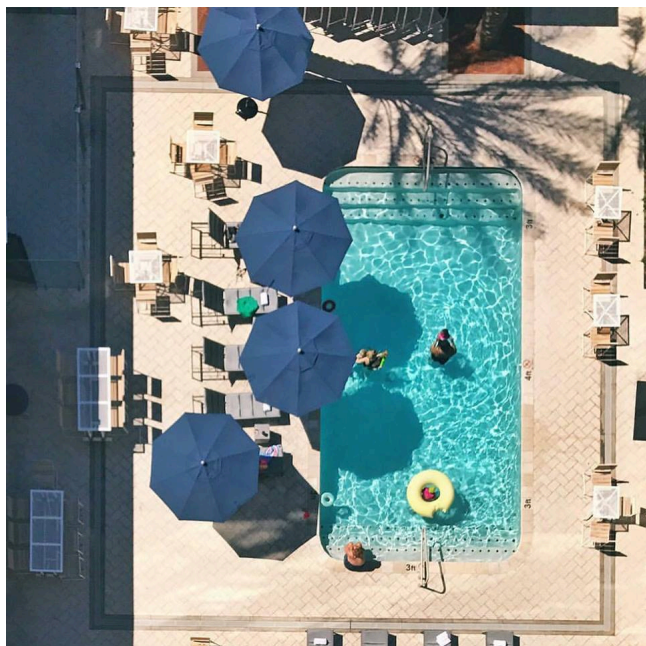


10 Things to do This Weekend in Phoenix: Labor Day Edition

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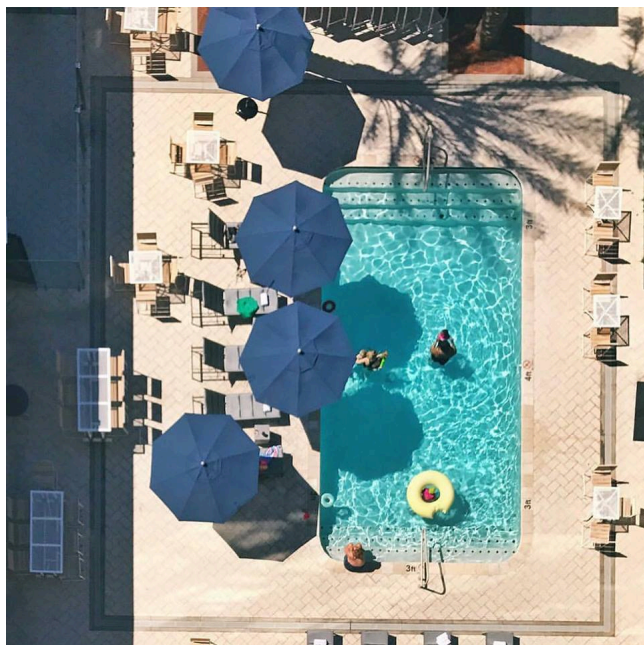
