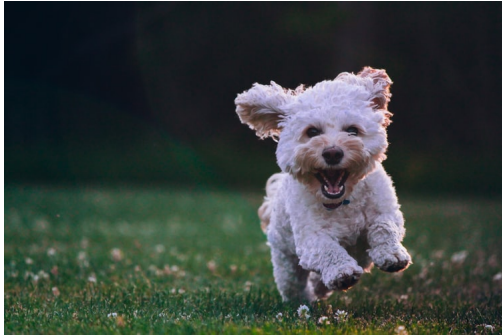


10 Things to do This Weekend in Phoenix

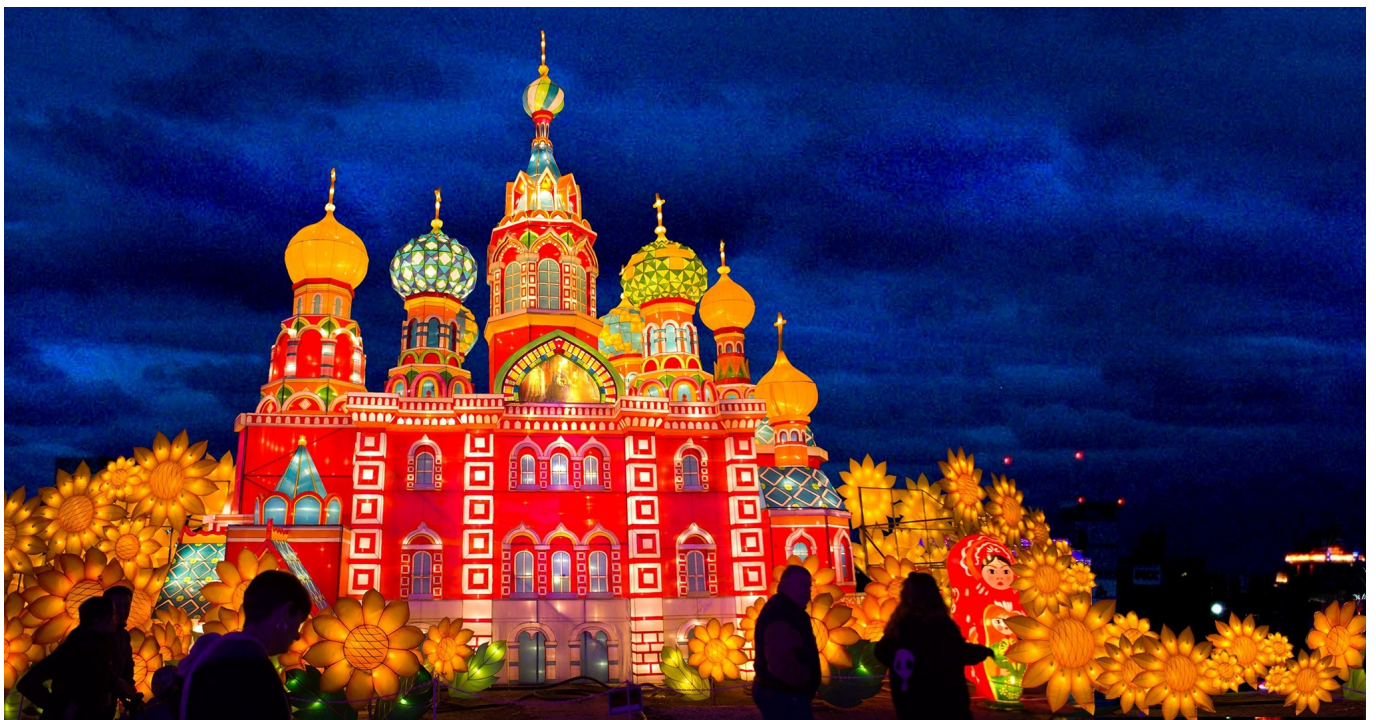

Trevor Noah at Talking Stick Resort Arena

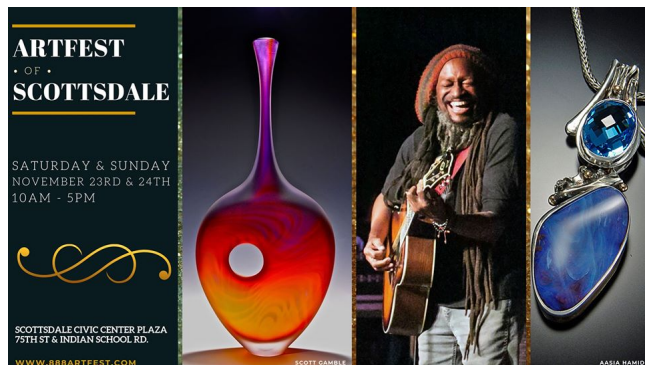
Have laugh with Trevor Noah this weekend as he puts on a hilarious performance at Talking Stick Resort Arena, starting at 8 p.m. Noah is

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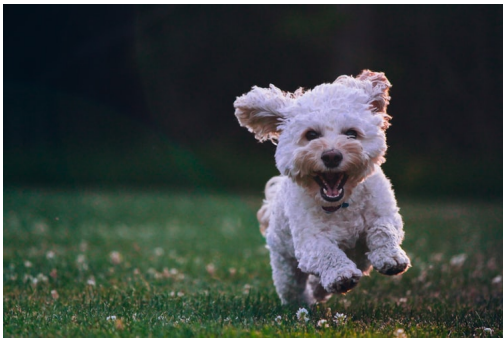
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Gilbert Days Rodeo
