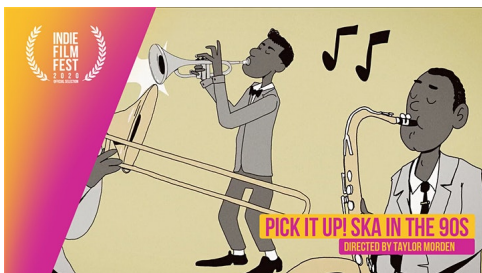
Bianco Cocktails and Bites at Pane Van Buren
