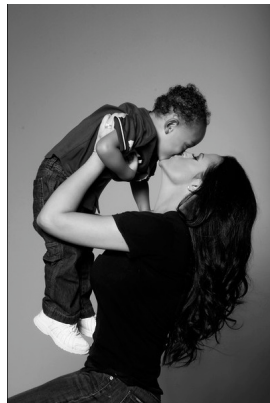


VH1 Star and Isaac Jewelers Partner Up For 'Miracles Do Happen'
