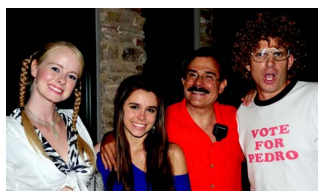
Meanwhile, you can catch the funny man at the Dodge this weekend. It's a five star stand up performance.
