"To be able to construct this area where families can be in comfort during stressful times is an honor," he added.



Bret says as someone who has spent his fair share of time in hospitals over the past few years, he knows how necessary it is for both patients and their loved ones to have a fun, welcoming place to recharge. "I designed this music and hospitality room to be that place."
