

This dinner is the brainchild of a Morton's corporate exec, **Roger Drake**, who has scored an amazing TOUCHDOWN in making this event a reality. Roger, a New York resident, has been a dedicated Cardinals fan, since the team was in St. Louis. "There were some lean years, but I stuck with them, going to as many games as I could in Arizona," says the executive who first thought of the idea in 2004 when Larry joined the Cardinals and he met Larry's father, a longtime sports editor for the Minnesota Spokesman-Recorder, at a sports event. Roger also has sentimental ties to teaming up with the Fitzgeralds. Roger's mother lost her battle to breast cancer when he was nine years old. Her name, as Larry's mother, was also Carol.
