Samy and Amy Bouzaglo who rose to infamous heights after they bullied their customers and employees on FOX's reality show "Gordon Ramsay's Kitchen Nightmares", say that the FBI is investigating their claims of someone hacking into their Facebook. Yes, the owners of Amy's Baking Company in Scottsdale, Arizona, claim someone else posted the outrageous responses to the venomous reviews of their restaurant.
