Jeremy Roenick, the popular former Phoenix Coyotes and Chicago Blackhawks star is now selling his sprawling north Scottsdale home. The hockey star hopes to fetch \$8.5 million for the 10,000 square-foot mansion.

The TWENTY-ACRE compound not only has a separate 2,000 sq. foot guest home, a three- hole putting green , but a baseball field!



Once behind Jeremy's private gates, the long driveway takes you to the main home. The dream home boasts seven bedrooms, (TWO master bedrooms!) seven and a half baths, a wine room, theatre and game room. There's no homeowner's association and if you might have a luxurious California beach home you want to sell, Jeremy may consider a trade for a Solana beach, Del Mar or other coastal beach city home.



"I love this Southwestern inspired Architecture, " says Frank Aazami of Russ Lyon Sotheby's International Realty, who is the listing agent. "They integrate regional organic materials into the design, including heavy beams carved from dead standing timbers, weathered copper, and natural fieldstone. From the exterior the home blends in with the surrounding botanical cacti, granite boulders, appearing as though it has existed for generations as part of the natural landscape."
