With John's very demanding multi-city tour across the country, (which he began with a six-week holiday engagement on Broadway in January 2015) it's a priceless bonding experience for actor and son.



The theatre experience of the popular storyline of two murderers who become celebrities, **John Kander**, **Fred Ebb** and **Joe Fosse's** Tony winning Chicago, has been touring for about 17 years. John O'Hurley has been a big part of its history, first appearing on Broadway as **Billy Flynn** in 2006. It's the longest running American musical in Broadway history.

By the way, playing the slick lawyer Billy Flynn, in the roaring twenties era musical is a fitting role for the dashing classically trained vocalist. The TV star is also a recording artist and a bestselling author of three books, including "The Perfect Dog" inspired by his son!

Currently the razzle dazzle of Chicago's award winning music, choreography and All that Jazz... is playing in Reno, Nevada at the Pioneer Center for the Performing Arts through April 26.
