The special is available every day from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. (must purchase entree to redeem bottomless offer). Then, head to the lobby bar from 4 to 6 p.m. every day for a pre-dinner tipple. The Garland offers four new specialty cocktails for "Spritz Hour." A standout is the summer-ready MacMurray's Method Spritz, which is a porton pisco acholado, pineapple juice, lemon, pinot noir and a splash of lemon lime soda.
