

Only about 5% of dental professionals go on to complete the additional education required to become orthodontists; and only 1.7% go on to become board certified by the American Board of Orthodontics, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

After completing an undergraduate pre-dental bachelor's degree, every dentist and orthodontist completes a four-year dental school program to become a Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.) or a Doctor of Dental Medicine (D.M.D.). Orthodontists then go on to complete an additional two or three-year orthodontic graduate program to obtain a Masters of Science (MS) degree in Orthodontics. For dentists to offer Invisalign, all they have to do complete a mere 10 continuing education hours.

ABO Certified Smyl Co Orthodontists vs. Non-ABO Certified Orthodontists

Smyl Co.'s orthodontists are all board certified by the American Board of Orthodontics (ABO). The ABO was created to continually improve the overall quality of orthodontic specialty care. This re-evaluation, or continued re-certification, is to ensure improvement of skills. Nonmembers go unevaluated for years, and skills can decline rather than improve.
