Someone in Fountain Hills sure had a lucky day yesterday. Two winning tickets were sold for yesterday's \$579.9 million Powerball jackpot--one in Fountain Hills, the other in Kansas City. Each will receive \$289.9 million if they choose the 30-year annuity option or nearing \$190 million if they opt for lump-sum cash.
